

Shortcuts

These shortcuts are very handy, especially the rotation and mirroring which is easy to remember.

Main-tools toolbar (Left toolbar)

q – Collection of commonly used tools

w – Tiling tools

e – zooming tools

r – Measuring tools

t – Weeding line tools

y – registration mark tools

u – tool for objects

Sub-tools toolbar (Lower toolbar)

z – Pointer tool, move and deleting tiling lines

x – Add vertical tiling line

c – Add horizontal tile line

v – Add short vertical line

b – Manual tile overlap

n – Activate / deactivate tiles by clicking inside them

m – deactivate all tiles

Tab - Rotate 90 degrees

Shift+Tab - Rotate for minimal vinyl usage:

Ctrl+Tab - Mirror image

Ctrl+O - Open new image

1 - Import latest image under the import-folder

Shift+1 - Choose specific file under the import-folder

2 - Read vinyl-size (for supported plotters)

3 - Calculate automatic tiles + automatic weed lines

4 - Cut out (opens the cut out dialogue):

Shift+4 - Preview 1 copy:

7 - Open the image-dialogue:

8 - Open the measuring frame dialogue: >

9 - Open the tiles-dialogue:

0 - Open the cutter-dialogue:

F11 - Open the Settings-dialogue:

F6 - Delete all weedinglines:

F7 - Delete all registrationmarks

F8 - Toggle whole / adapted area

F9 - Toggle wireframe / fill viewmode

Space - Toggle tiles, registrationmarks & weeding tools

Shift+Space - Toggle measuring, rotation & object tools

Ctrl+Space - Toggle between the available colours

The most commonly used shortcuts is the Tab-key in various use with Shift and Ctrl in order to rotate or mirror the active image/colours layer. Also the 1,2,3,4 buttons are popular for simple signs, like when cutting a simple text or one-colour signs. As easy as 1-2-3-4 ;)
